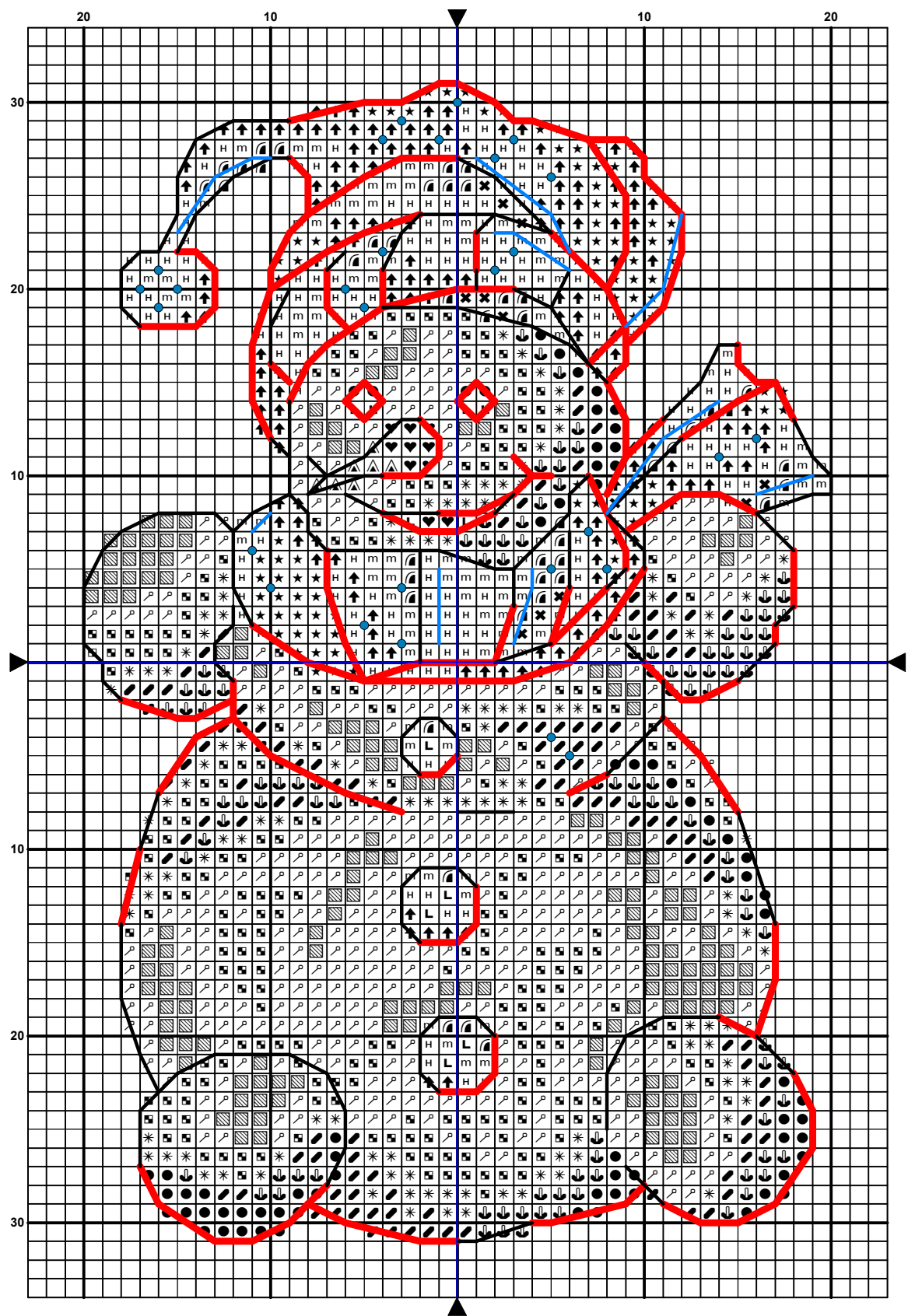
Used stitches: full cross, few french knots, backstitch

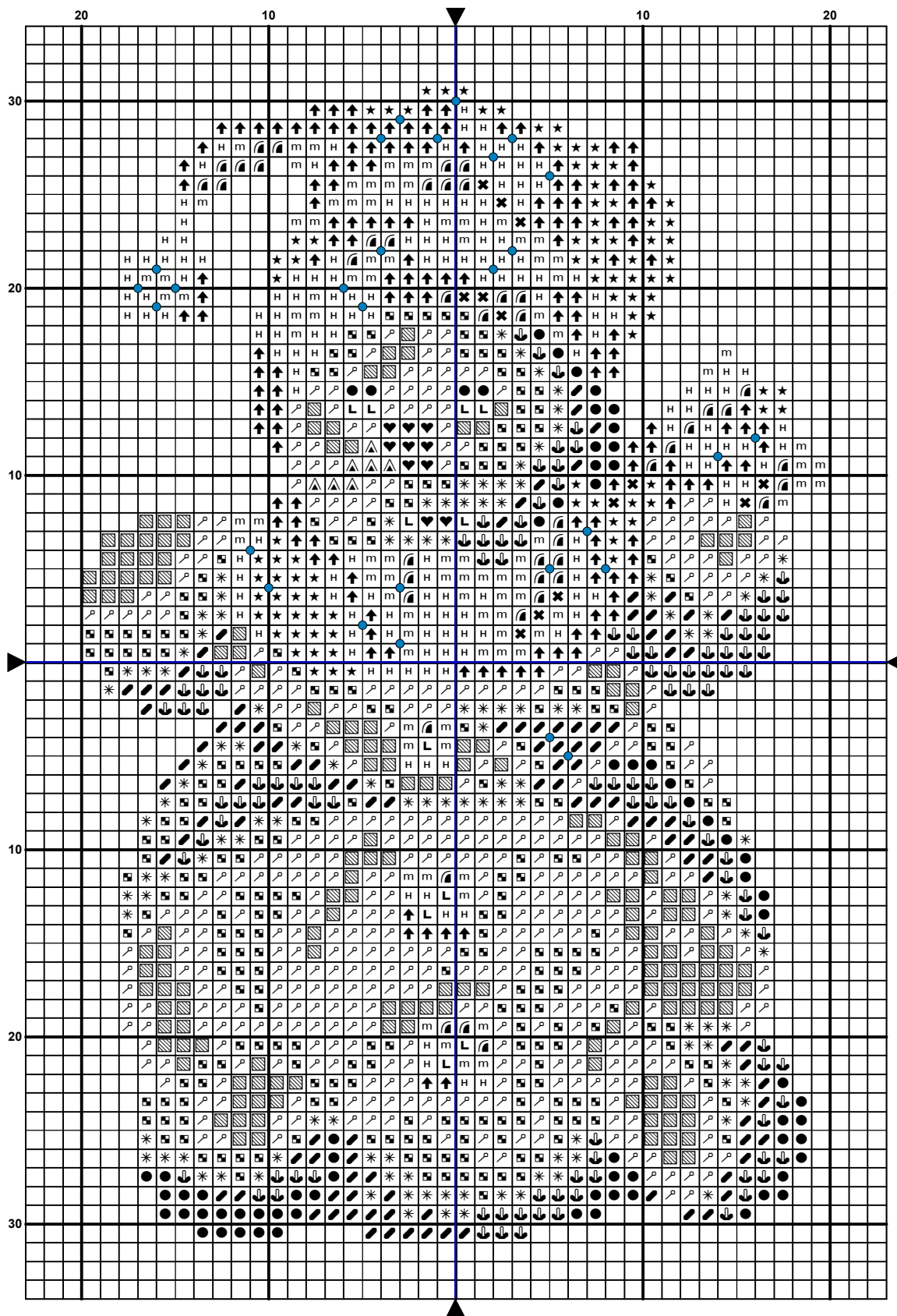

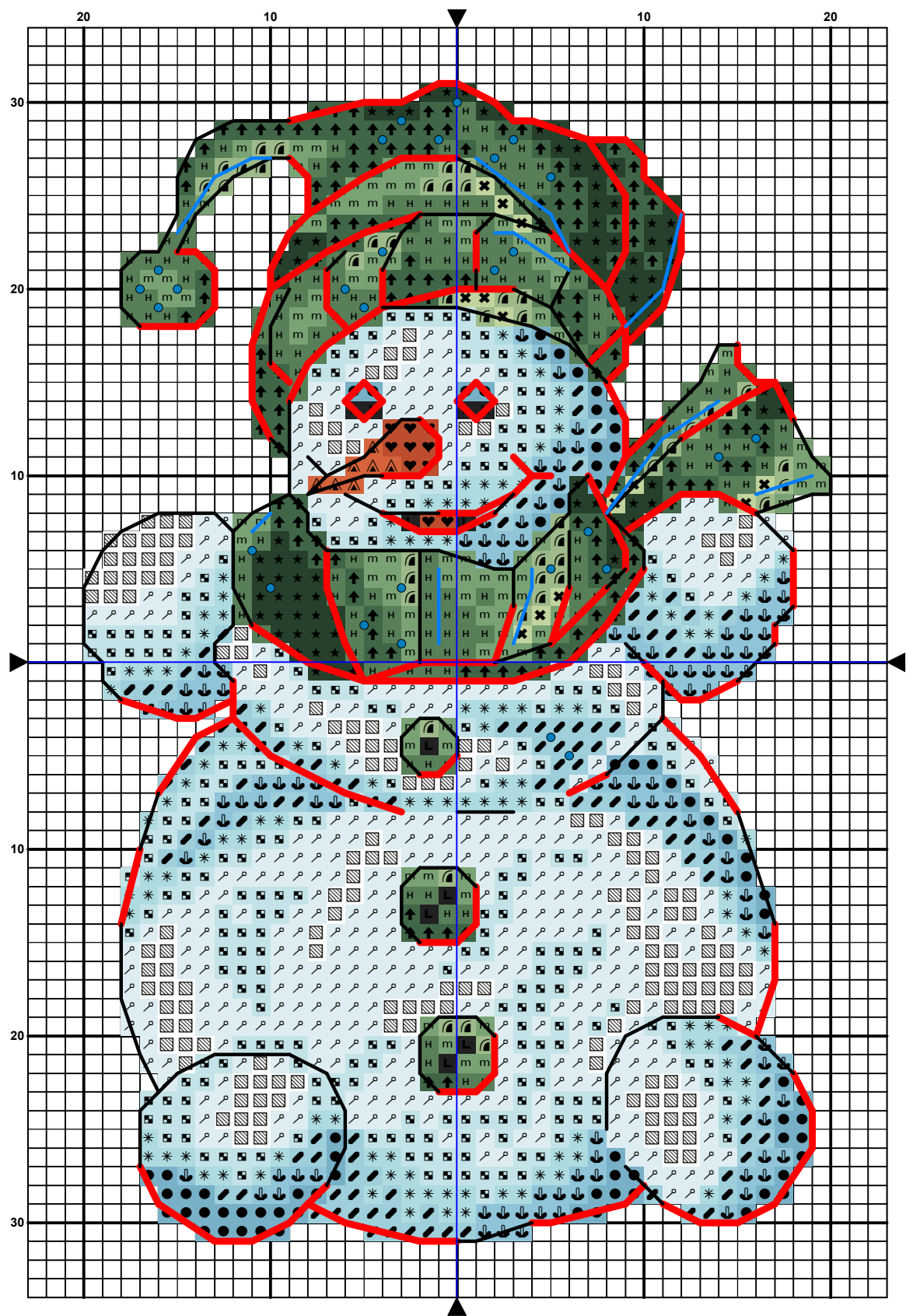

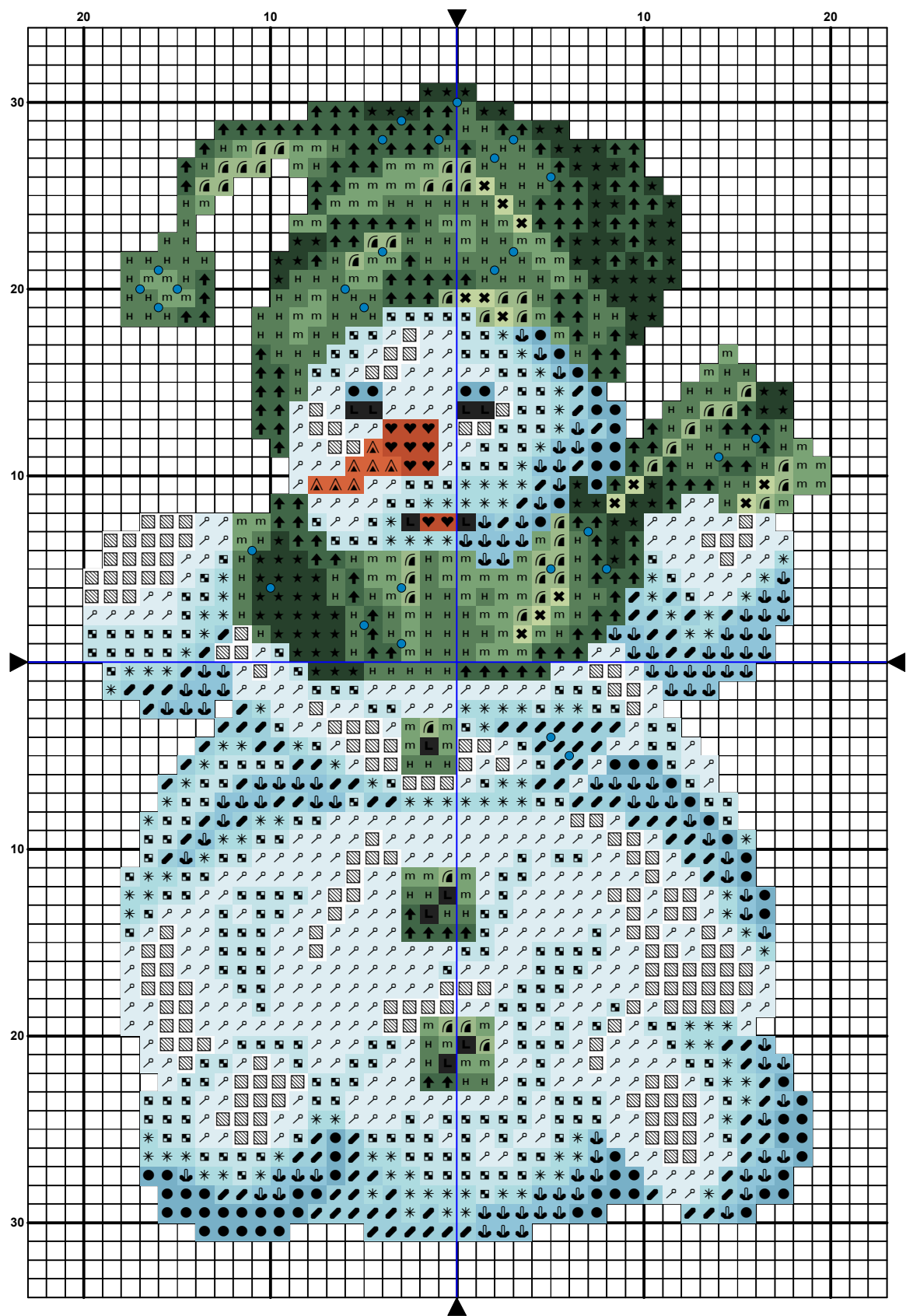
